### How to participate in March Munch 2018 (non-registered schools)

1. Download and distribute March Munch challenge cards to each student. Students place a sticker, stamp or tick on their card each day they eat vegetables for Crunch&Sip®. Ask students to also write or draw the vegetable eaten. A newsletter insert and parent letter are available on our website to help promote the event.
2. Each day during the first and last week of March Munch record the number of students in class and the number with vegetables for Crunch&Sip® on the tables on the next page.
3. Download and distribute mathematics worksheets to incorporate March Munch into classroom lessons (optional). The worksheets vary in difficulty and it is left to each teacher to pick the most suitable activity for their class.
4. Jump online in mid-April to download the March Munch state results. Your class might like to compare their results with the state-wide snapshot.
